**MINUTES**

**1. Call to order and declaration of a quorum present.**

Mayor Cox called the meeting to order and declared a quorum to be present at 5:50 p.m.

**3. Discussion and public comment concerning the 2021-2022 Purcell Municipal Hospital Fiscal Year Budget.**

Ms. Morris, CFO for Purcell Municipal Hospital. She explained that this year's budget is derived by dividing the year in half. The Hospital took an average from July 1 thru December 31 and then based January thru June expected revenue and expense. The Capital items are for things that we know we will need in the new facility. PMH has already been setting money back for capital items.

Mayor Cox asked if the budget represents any cost associated with old facility once the new facility is open. Ms. Morris advised it does not. He recapped for clarification that there is nothing being considered in the budget, for doctors that might remain in the building while they are still completing a new medical office. Ms. Morris answered no. Ms. Morris stated she shows PMH vacating the current facility and the hospital considered the building would be there for any physicians that might remain in it.

Mayor Cox asked if the budget reflects Sales Tax stopping after January 1, 2022. Ms. Morris advised yes it does.

Mayor Cox called for any public comment on the presented budget.

Hospital Chairman advised the reason the hospital did not make any allowances for those things is that the facility is in such bad shape and is being operated with band aids with chillers. They made those assumptions that the city would have some reconciliation for those things.

**4. Adjourn.**

Mayor Cox declared the meeting to be adjourned at 5:55 p.m.
